Setup: Arrange 3 teams of two.

More often than not, we predetermine a movie quality based on its promotional material, a title, a synopsis, a poster, but is that enough to judge a movie fairly?

Based on a gameshow I think I've seen once - Film Critics.

You will see 12 movie prompts.

For each movie, the first team must pick either its poster, title or synopsis and guess its IMDB score at the time of writing. The next team picks one of the 2 remaining choices and guess its score and the last team gets to judge the movie with all three options revealed.

The closest team gets a point and gets to pick first for the next movie.

The team with the most points after 12 movies goes on to the bonus round.

(All questions are in the game, no need for a rules sheet)

Bonus round

The winning team must rate 3 movies, one based just on its title, one just on its synopsis and one just on its poster.

The goal is to get as close as possible to the combined score.

There are no prizes, so just make it as close as you can.
